- 1. Title or Purpose:** Contracting Certification and Warrant Program
- 2. File in:** Commerce Acquisition Manual (CAM) Part 1, Subpart 6
1301.6
- 3. Effective:** October 1, 2014
- 4. Applicability:** The Department of Commerce (DOC) contracting personnel to include all employees in the contracting series (GS-1102) and all Contracting Officers, regardless of series, with authority to obligate funds above the micro-purchase threshold.
- 5. Supersedes:** CAM 1301.6, *Contracting Certification and Warrant Program* (March 2013).
- 6. Summary:** This chapter is hereby revised to implement the following revisions effective October 1, 2014:
 - Changes FAC-C training requirements to more closely align with DOD's DAWIA training curriculum;
 - Establishes a requirement that all Contracting Officers issued an unlimited warrant after October 1, 2014 must have a FAC-C Level III;
 - Updates competencies and adds performance outcomes for each certification level; and
 - Identifies the Federal Acquisition Institute Training Application System (FAITAS) as the official system of record for the FAC-C program and requires all contracting professionals to register and maintain training records in FAITAS.
