

Sensitive Items

Non-expendable items that may be converted to private use, or have a high potential for theft shall be recorded and controlled as accountable equipment. For the purpose of this Manual, such items are referred to as sensitive items. Regardless of cost the following sensitive items include, but are not limited to:

- a. Firearms
- b. Desktop and Tower Computers
- c. Laptop, Notebook, and other Portable Computers
- d. Hand-held Computers
- e. Color Printers
- f. Laser Printers
- g. Desktop Plotters
- h. Graphic Tablets
- i. CD-ROM Disk Drives (read and write)
- j. External SCSI Disk Drives
- k. External "Firewire" Disk Drives
- l. Desktop Scanners
- m. Hand-held Scanners
- n. Digital Cameras
- o. Video Cameras
- p. Televisions
- q. Video Cassette Recorders and Players
- r. Fax Machines
- s. Multi-purpose Fax, Printer, Copy Machines
- t. Global Positioning System (GPS) Devices
- u. Photocopy Machines
