SUBJECT: Secure Flight Program (FedTraveler.com users only)

EFFECTIVE DATE: Immediately

EXPIRATION DATE: Effective until cancelled or superseded

BACKGROUND: In response to recommendations made by the 9/11 Commission Report, the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) developed the Secure Flight Program to enhance the security of domestic and international commercial air travel through the use of prescreening passenger information against Federal Government watch lists.

PURPOSE: To notify FedTraveler.com users of changes to the Secure Flight Program. Secure Flight is a behind the scenes program managed by the Transportation Security Administration that streamlines the watch list matching process. After matching passenger information from the airlines against Government watch lists, Secure Flight transmits matching results back to airlines. This serves to prevent individuals on the "No Fly List" from boarding an aircraft. The program provides enhanced aviation security and more effectively facilitates air travel for passengers while protecting individuals' privacy.

PROCEDURES: FedTraveler.com electronically stores the travelers' personal profile information to make travel arrangements. The profile information will be incorporated in the ticket data, which will be used by Secure Flight for watch list matching; therefore, the information contained in FedTraveler must match exactly the government-issued identification used to board an airplane. Follow the link <https://www.FedTraveler.com> to "User Profile," and complete the required fields in the Secure Flight Information area on the first page. Your name must match exactly with what is shown on your government-issued identification (i.e., driver license or passport) used when traveling and making travel reservations. This may or may not include your middle name or initial, so you should be sure to check your identification!

New travelers will need their bureau's Company Pin. Your information will not be saved to your User Profile in FedTraveler.com until you enter your User PIN and click on "Save User Profile." The Company Pin for your bureau is one of the following:
