What is "The Security Buzz"

The Office of Security "OSY" is introducing our security newsletter that will be published monthly and distributed to employees to aid in security awareness and education. We will be addressing current security issues and will answer questions emailed to: Debra.Kay.Rochner@Census.Gov.

What and Who is "OSY"?

OSY is an acronym for the "Office of Security." OSY is located in Building 66, Rooms 104 and 110. Sydney Deane is the Regional Security Officer. He supervises five employees who make up the OSY staff at the National Processing Center (NPC). They include three Security Specialists - Debra Rochner, Brian Fleenor, and Dianne Stewart and two Security Assistants - Barbara Brown and Larry Foster. We also currently have one contractor, Robert Jenkins, assisting in the rebadging operation.

Who is "Buzz?"

Buzz is our new security mascot, introduced in late 2006, developed to spread security awareness. You will see him on our weekly post hours, our bulletin boards, on our website, and more. He will be making more appearances in the future, so be on the look out for him.

What are Safety/Security Boards?

Throughout the installation you will see large 4' x 8' bulletin boards entitled "Safety/Security." This is where you will find important Safety and Security postings. These boards are updated at least once a month, so keep watching them for new information.

New Badges, why?

OSY has rebadged all employees and contractors at NPC due to badges expiring and requirements of Homeland Security Presidential Directive-12 (HSPD-12). HSPD-12 requires specific security procedures be followed in acquiring a badge and safely storing information related to that badge. You should protect your badge as it is your means to enter the buildings at NPC. Should it become lost or stolen, IMMEDIATELY notify Security on extension x3595.

Who is SecTek?

SecTek is the new contract guard service. You will notice most of the same officers that have been providing security services are still on board, with the addition of a few new faces and uniforms. Introduction of individual officers are highlighted monthly on the Security/Safety bulletin boards.
